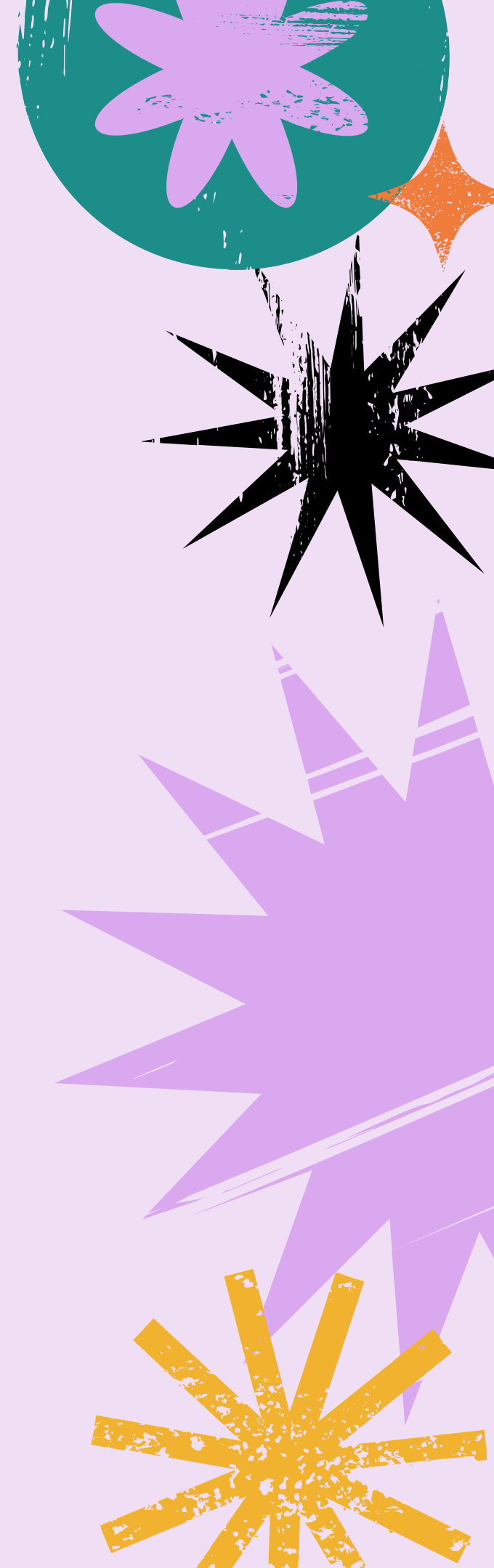




Accessing the Workspace

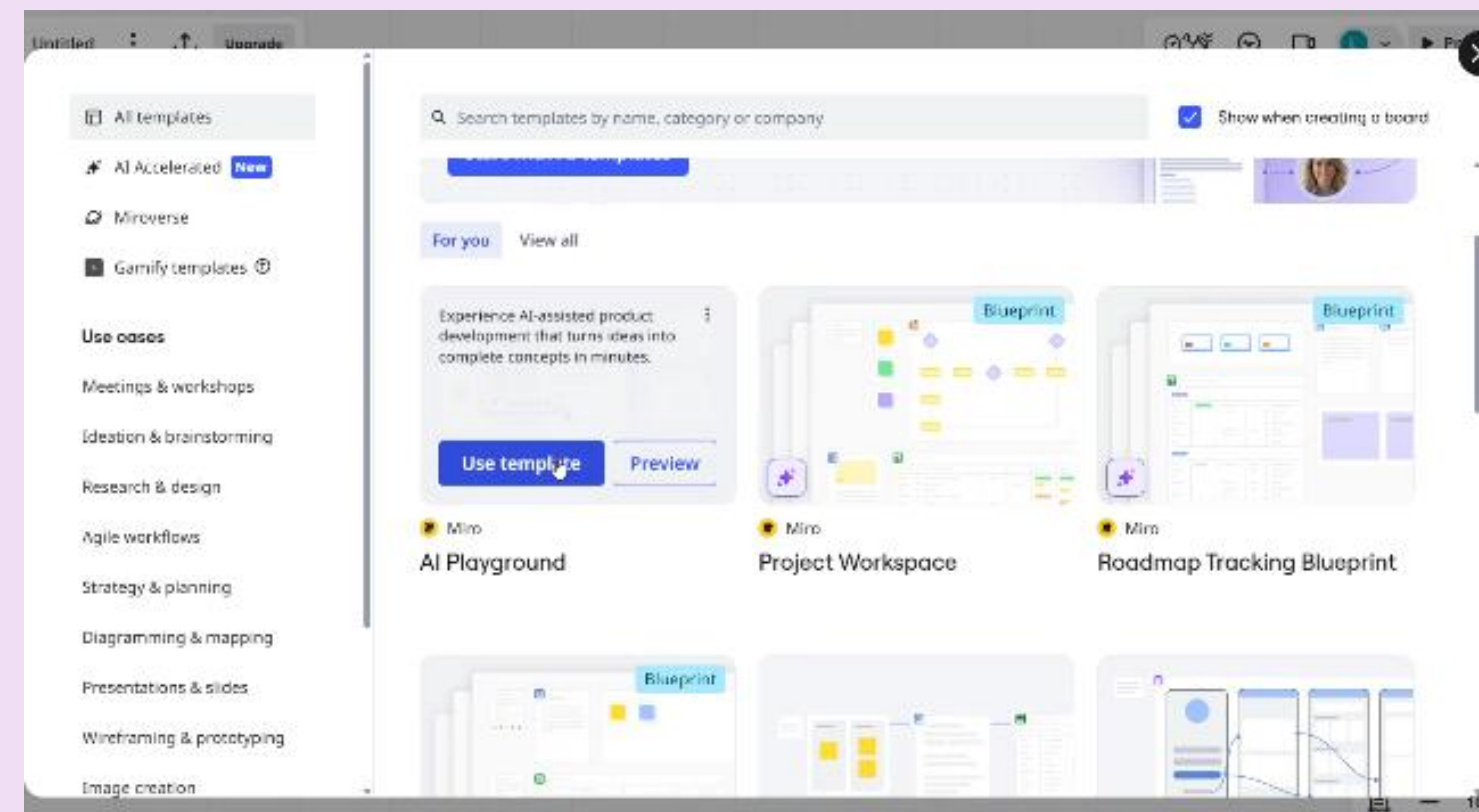

By clicking “Create board,” users open a blank canvas.

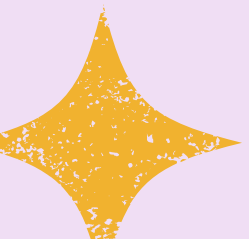
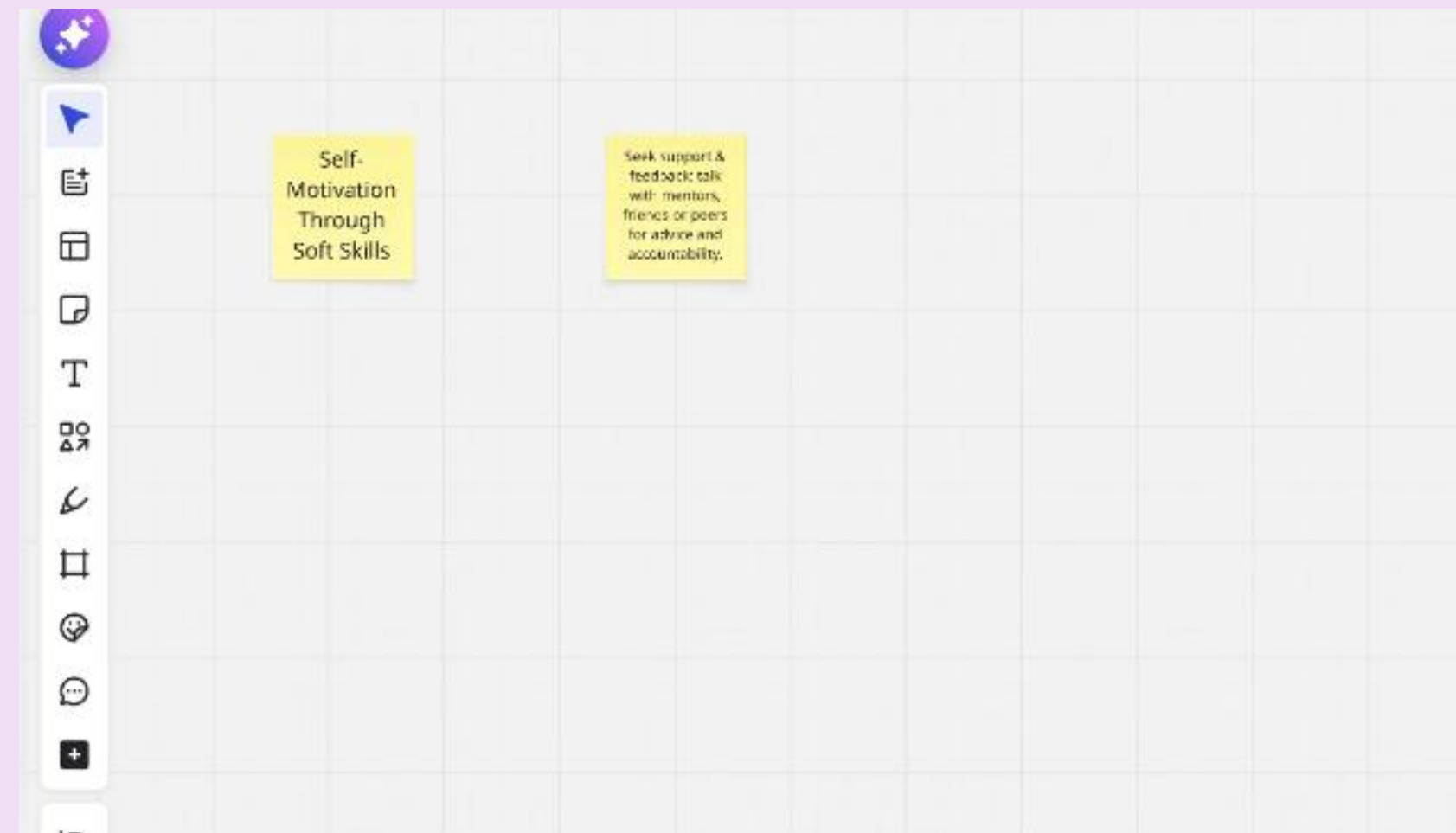
Users create a new board to organize ideas, tasks, or learning activities in a visual format.



Using Visual Tools

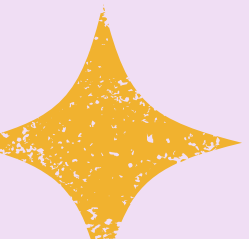
Miro allows users to add sticky notes, images, diagrams, and text to explore ideas and set goals.

Items on the board can be grouped, moved, or connected to create structured plans and workflows.



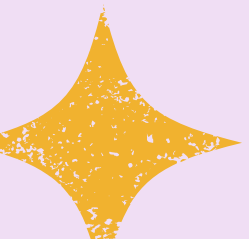
Real-Time Collaboration

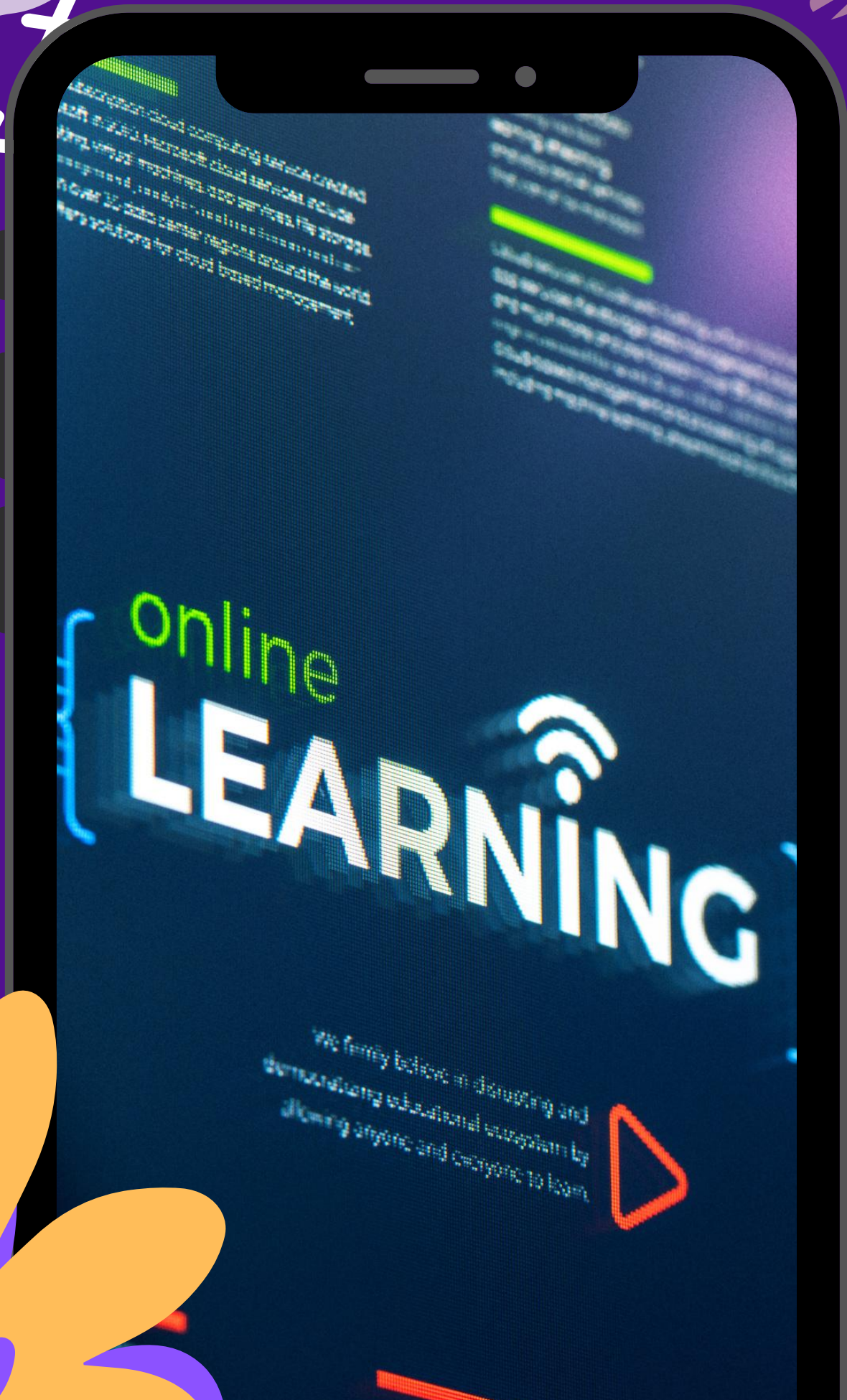
Multiple users can work on the same board at the same time, sharing ideas and feedback.
